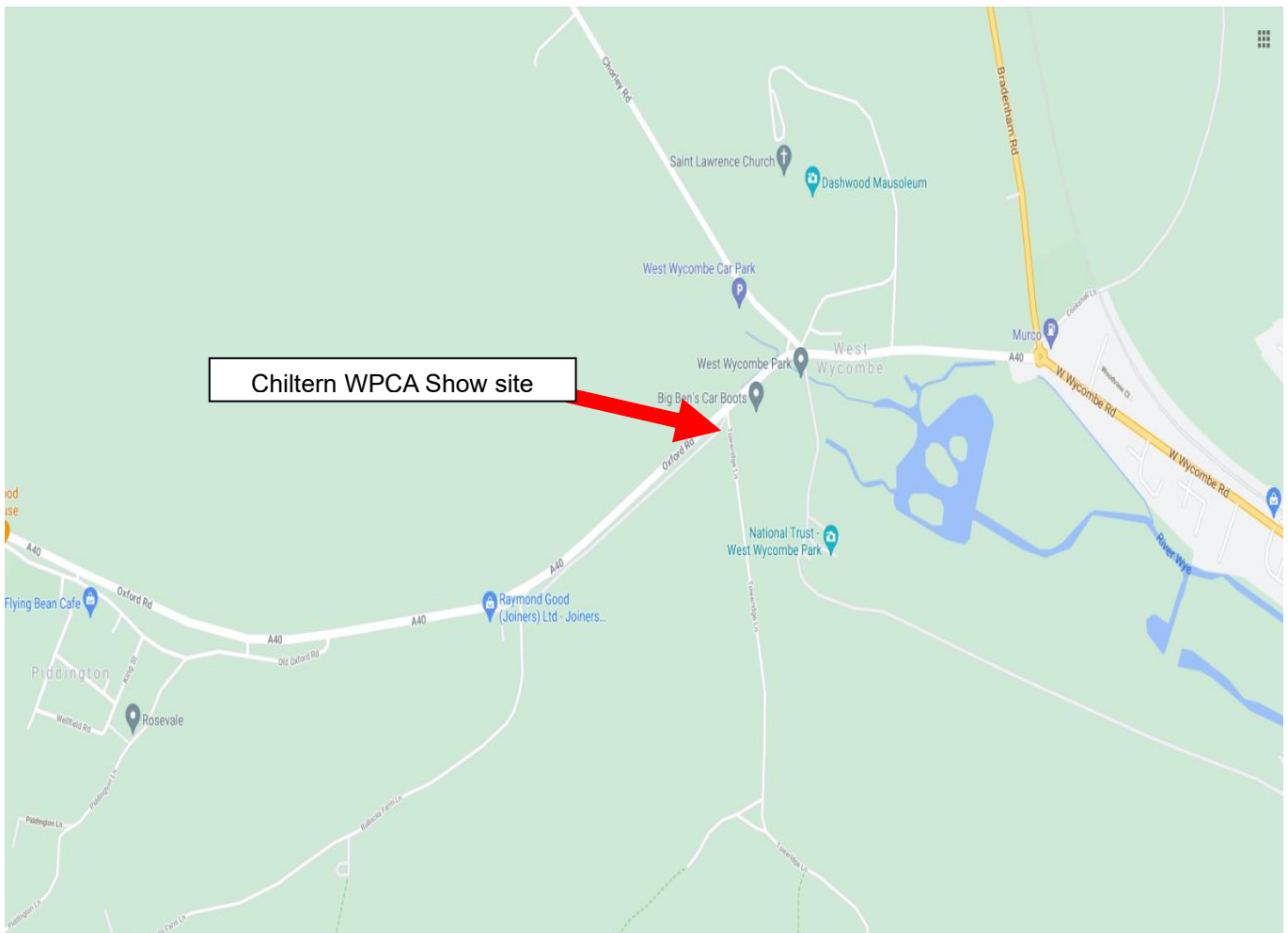
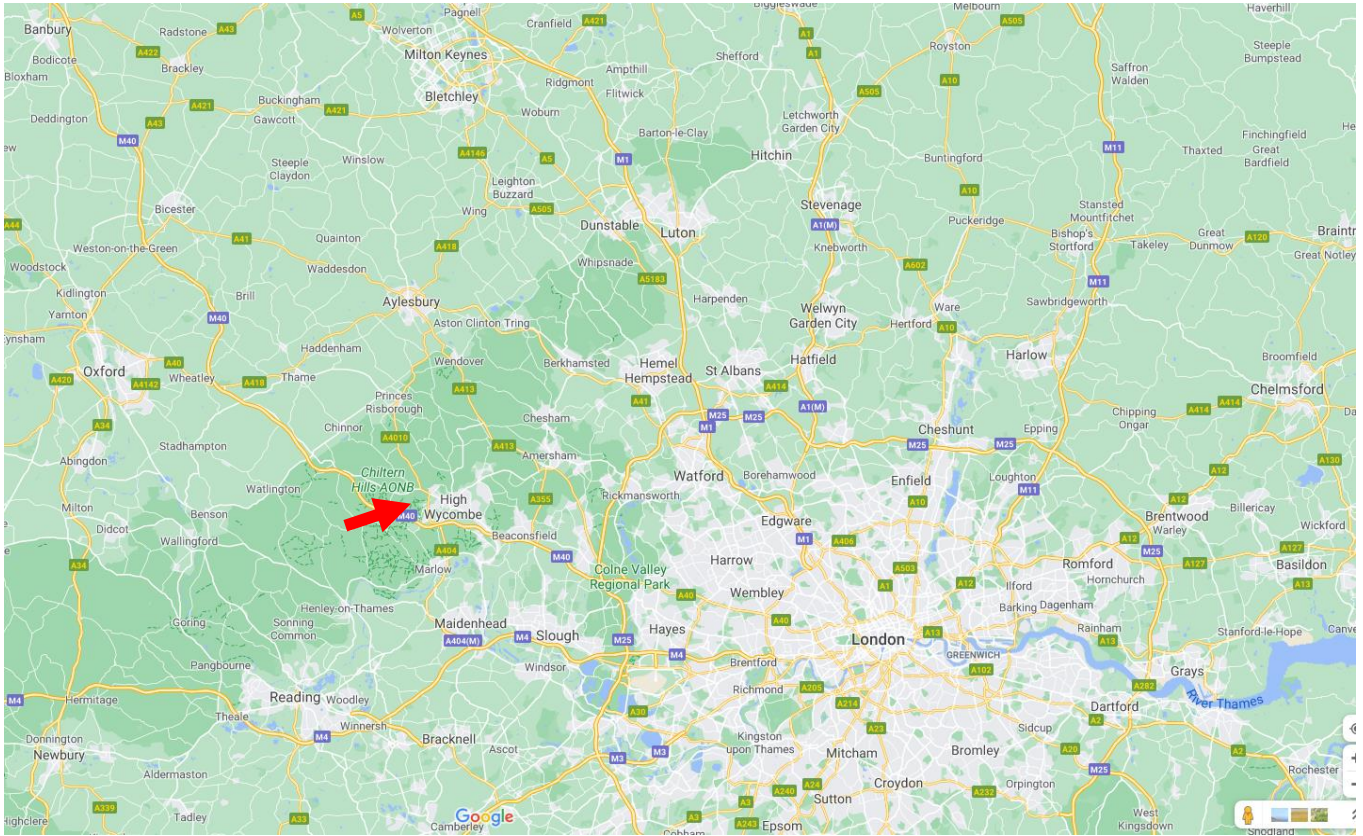

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) The Show Committee, Judges/Officials, or their associates will accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any persons, animals or property however caused. Exhibitors are required to have their own personal liability insurance.
- 2) The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or alter any event and to add, substitute or remove any judge from any class or championship & amalgamate classes if there are less than 3 entries.
- 3) The Judge's decision is final.
- 4) Objections/complaints must be made within **one hour** of the event occurring and be lodged at the secretary's office together with a deposit of £50, which is refundable if the objection is upheld.
- 5) Entry fees will not be refunded without a veterinary certificate.
- 6) If the show is cancelled all entry fees will be returned UNLESS the show is re-scheduled.
- 7) Any exhibit not sufficiently under control shall be removed from the ring at the request of the Judge or Steward.
- 8) Brood Mares, Stallions & Ridden exhibits must be 4 years old or over.
- 9) All colts & stallions 2yrs old and over must be bitted and led by a handler that is 14yrs or over on the 1st January of the current year.
- 10) Affiliated ridden ponies must be 4yrs old & over and registered in the appropriate section of the relevant stud book.
- 11) All foals must be three weeks old or over on the day of the show and accompanied by their mother.
- 12) Animals, 3 years old and under, including foals, must not be body clipped for showing purposes. Long hair under the jawline and those protruding from the ears may be trimmed off leaving as natural a line as possible.
- 13) **Whiskers should not be trimmed.** Following the FEI general assembly held 23 November 2020, a new rule that prohibits the clipping/ shaving of sensory hairs on the muzzle was passed as part of the veterinary regulations. This has been implemented on welfare grounds.
- 14) Correctly secured current British standard riding hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted. No Spurs to worn in any ridden class.
- 15) No lunging of ponies in the warm-up arena.
- 16) All handlers/drivers under the age of 14 must wear a British Standard hard hat.
- 17) All young drivers must be aged 8 years or over on the first day of the show which they are to compete. A driver under the age of 18 must be accompanied in the turnout by an adult groom (over the age of 18 years), who themselves is a competent carriage driver. This always applies not just to the show ring but on the showground. SHOW ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO ASK FOR PROOF OF AGE OF THE GROOM. When in the vehicle grooms, passenger/s and driver must have their feet firmly on the floor of the vehicle or use a suitable fixed footrest.
- 18) No driver under the age of 16 years may drive a stallion either in the ring or on the showground.
- 19) If during the final championship classes, the Judges cannot come to a decision we will ask 'someone' to come forward to cast the final decision. This person does not have to be on the judging panel, as these are not Medal/Rosette classes.
- 20) The CWPCA Committee will request competitor to leave the ring /showground if deemed cruel or abusive to their animal.
- 21) The exhibitor of any animal displaying sign of disease/illness shall be asked to leave.
- 22) Anyone causing a disturbance or found leaving litter/box bedding will be asked to leave the showground immediately, forfeiting any entry fees.
- 23) Children are to be supervised at all times.
- 24) Dogs to be kept under strict control.
- 25) This is a Victoria food company championship qualifier. The champion will qualify for the grand final to held on Sunday 11th September 2022 at Bury Farm equestrian club, new Bury Farm, mill road, Slapton Bucks, LU7 9BT. In the event that the champion or first place in the class has already qualified then the reserve champion or the second placing qualify. if the reserve or second has also qualified, the rosette to be awarded back to the champion or first placed. once qualified, the horse, whip and vehicle may not be changed.

*NPS - To be run under NPS rules 2022. In all NPS classes, ridden stallions **MUST** display a stallion bridle marker.

** WPCS All exhibitors in affiliated Welsh Breed classes must abide by the current WPCS judging and showing rules.

INFORMATION FOR QUALIFIERS
Welsh Pony & Cob Society WPCS Rosette

Rosette's will be awarded as follows:

WPCS Rosette - Section Champion A, B, C, D and Part Bred

NPS - NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part Breds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/ handler's possession on entering the ring and produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette can be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony have previously qualified it is still entitled to the silver medal rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (Third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

The Driving Classes are open to all breeds.

All Horses/Ponies must be 4 years and over.

Each turnout must have a competent adult Groom/Passenger in Attendance

Class 74 – PLEASURE DRIVING – Pleasure driving classes are for newcomers to showing and not intended for those who show in Private Drive classes. Regular showing competitors are asked to respect this. To be judged on general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness, and suitability as a Pleasure Drive turnout.

Class 75 - EXERCISE VEHICLE- Open to single, pair or tandem to a 2 or 4 wheel exercise vehicle. Carriages not of a traditional design – lamps need not be carried. Judging will include general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and vehicle suitability.

Class 76 – YOUNG DRIVER- Open to drivers aged 17 and under on show date driving traditional/traditional type vehicles or an exercise vehicle fitted with traditional/traditional type wheels. Lamps need not be carried. This class is judged to determine the capabilities of the driver, and particular attention will be paid to the dress, turnout and driving procedure. A competent, experienced adult groom aged 18 years or over to be carried at all times.

Class 77 - PRIVATE DRIVING- Open to single, pairs or tandem to traditional vehicles.

Class 78 – LIGHT TRADE- Open to horses and ponies 4 years or over, singles and pairs to a traditional or a traditional type trade vehicle. No goods to be carried or displayed. A small sample load may be carried on a coster turnout only.

Class 79 – WELSH SECTION A, B & C- Open to registered ponies to be shown in a show wagon.

Class 80 - WELSH SECTION D- Open to registered horses/ponies to be shown in a show wagon.
