



RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) The Show Committee, Judges/Officials, or their associates will accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any persons, animals or property however caused. Exhibitors are required to have their own personal liability insurance.
- 2) The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or alter any event and to add, substitute or remove any judge from any class or championship & amalgamate classes if there are less than 3 entries.
- 3) The Judge's decision is final.
- 4) Threatening, unruly, abusive, offensive language or conduct towards Committee/staff/Judges/stewards or fellow competitors will not be tolerated.
- 5) All Exhibitors must agree & abide by the Chiltern WPCA Complaints Policy and Procedure.
- 6) Entry fees will <u>not</u> be refunded without a veterinary certificate.
- 7) If the show is cancelled all entry fees will be returned UNLESS the show is re-scheduled.
- 8) Any exhibit not sufficiently under control shall be removed from the ring at the request of the Judge or Steward.
- 9) Brood Mares, Stallions & ridden exhibits must be 4 years old or over.
- 10) All colts & stallions 2yrs old and over must be bitted and led by a handler that is 14yrs or over on the 1st January of the current year.
- 11) Affiliated ridden ponies must be 4yrs old & over and registered in the appropriate section of the relevant stud book.
- 12) All foals must be three weeks old or over on the day of the show and accompanied by their mother.
- 13) Animals, 3 years old and under, including foals, must not be body clipped for showing purposes. Long hair under the jawline and those protruding from the ears may be trimmed off leaving as natural a line as possible.
- 14) Whiskers should not be trimmed. Following the FEI general assembly held 23 November 2020, a new rule that prohibits the clipping/ shaving of sensory hairs on the muzzle was passed as part of the veterinary regulations. This has been implemented on welfare grounds.
- 15) Correctly secured current British standard riding hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted. No Spurs to worn in any ridden class.
- 16) No lunging of ponies in the warm-up arena.
- 17) All handlers/drivers under the age of 14 must wear a British Standard hard hat.
- 18) If during the final championship classes, the Judges cannot come to a decision, we will ask 'someone' to come forward to cast the final decision. This person does not have to be on the judging panel, as these are not Medal/Rosette classes.
- 19) The CWPCA Committee will request competitor to leave the ring /showground if deemed cruel or abusive to their animal. The CWPCA may refer this to the appropriate authority.
- 20) The exhibitor of any animal displaying sign of disease/illness shall be asked to leave.
- 21) Anyone causing a disturbance or found leaving litter/box bedding will be asked to leave the showground immediately, forfeiting any entry fees.
- 22) Children are to be supervised at all times.
- 23) Dogs to be kept under strict control.

TGCA Toys In hand and ridden classes Affiliation No 23/2705/ULT & 23/2808/ULT

No known breeding required to enter these classes.

TGCA breed classes are qualifiers for the best of breed finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA) National breed championship show "TOYS". Classes are open to all Traditional Gypsy Cobs.

Part Bred classes, are open to all part bred Traditional Gypsy Cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". The exhibit must have one parent that is bred Traditional Gypsy Cob.

Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class **MUST** be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, **MUST** be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rule book.

Current TGCA members must present their membership card and qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature.

Non-Members <u>MUST</u> receive a qualification card from the judge and have <u>21 days</u> to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to <u>www.tgca.co.uk</u> for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

Championships

Quest for star championship-TGCA 1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes above may go forward to the quest for a star championship as per below rule.

ONLY current TGCA members and horse/pony that is already TGCA registered can exhibit in this championship.

Membership card and members qualification card (specific to that exhibit) **MUST** be presented upon **entry into the ring.** The champion and reserve qualify for the ultimate star championships at TOYS.

Go for Glory championship – PB – 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} from the TGCA part bred classes may go forward to the Go for Glory championship. For the TOYS qualifiers the handler/rider and exhibits (apart from stallions) do not have to be TGCA members/registered on the date of the show. The champion and reserve qualify for the Crowning Glory championships at TOYS.

All in Hand Medal Sections are qualifiers for **The National Welsh Championship Show 2023 - National Gelding In Hand Championship** sponsored by Sarum Investments Ltd. All 1st & 2nd placed WPCS registered A,B,C,D & WPBR geldings in relevant classes (Not already qualified) qualify to enter.
